Rebecca Young Memorial Fund

As some of you may be aware, just before the start of this school year we lost one of our staff members to a sudden and unexpected death. Rebecca Young was to start her second year as the Life Skills teacher here at Dr. Kearney when on August 30th, 2015, at the young age of twenty-seven, she passed away after suffering from a major brain hemorrhage In Rebecca's short time here at Dr. Kearney, she demonstrated great compassion, energy and creativity with her students and the staff. Rebecca loved teaching and it showed each and everyday she was in the school. Her positive perspectives and creativeness was indeed contagious and commendable. She worked diligently to make a difference in the lives of the children she taught and the staff she worked with. The impact she made with not only the students but her fellow staff members and friends will not soon be forgotten. Besides being a wonderful teacher, Rebecca was also a talented musician and singer. She used this talent to connect with her students on a whole new level. With two of her siblings, Rebecca created a self-titled CD in 2010.

The Dr. Kearney staff is working to create three scholarships in Rebecca Young's memory. Through these scholarships, it is our hope to continue to share Rebecca's compassion and generosity with others. Our goal is to raise \$2000 this year. A scholarship in the amount of \$1000 will be awarded to a graduating student from North Peace Secondary School who will pursue a post-secondary program in special education. A scholarship in the amount of \$500 will be awarded to a graduating North Peace Secondary student who is destined to complete a degree program in Music. Finally, the remaining \$500 will be awarded to a special needs student graduating from North Peace Secondary School.
